

# TAKING LEGISLATURE TO THE PEOPLE

Members of the media are hereby informed that the Limpopo Legislature will embark on the programme “Taking Legislature to the People” from Tuesday, 11<sup>th</sup> November to Thursday, 13 November 2025.

The theme of the programme is *“Unlocking service delivery challenges through strengthening public participation and oversight mechanism”*.

Through the programme, Members of the Provincial Legislature (MPLs) will embark and perform oversight duties and functions on various service delivery site visits across the Sekhukhune District.

The programme will commence on 11<sup>th</sup> November (Tuesday) with the courtesy visit by the Speakership to the Queen Mother of the Bapedi Nation, Manyaku Thulare, at the Tjate Third Palace in Mohlaletsi, Sekhukhune District. This will be followed by another courtesy visit to the host local tribal office, under Kgoshi Legare Mashegoane.

MPLs will also be assigned over a two-day period through different oversight teams to cover all the municipalities under the Sekhukhune District.

The Office of the Speaker will lead stakeholder engagements sessions including traditional leaders youth, women, people with disabilities, churches, moral regeneration groups, women in business, and the taxi industry.

The programme will culminate with the sitting of the Legislature on Thursday, 13<sup>th</sup> November 2025 at the Peter Nchabeleng Sportsground, Schoonoord village, Makhuduthamaga Local Municipality (Sekhukhune District). The proceedings will start at 10H00.
